Memories, we're all going to make in the summer,

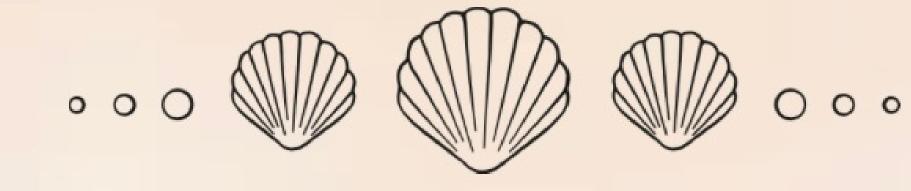

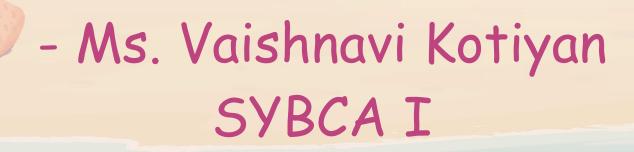
Unveiling the Untouched Magic of

our heart beholds.

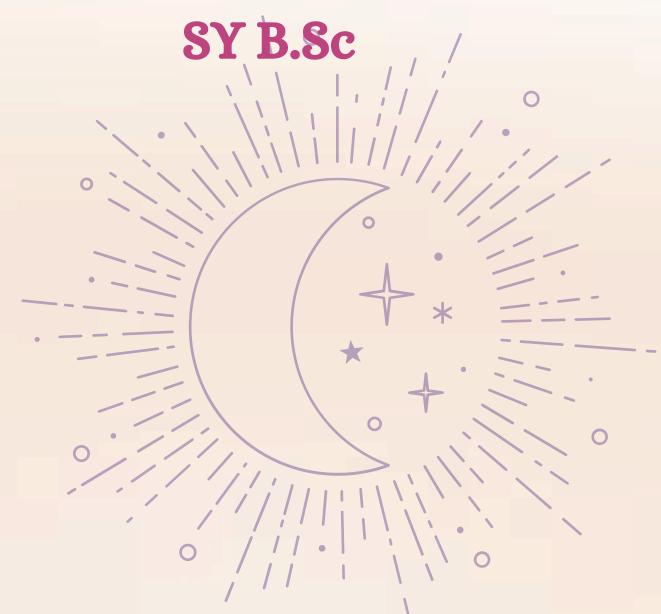


'YOU'.
