Summary of Activities Conducted:

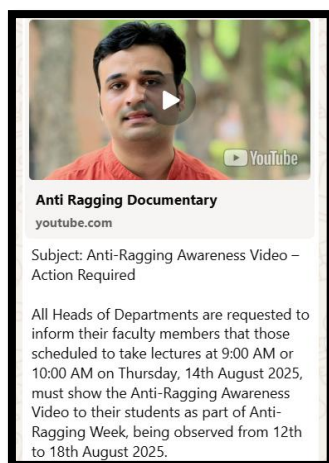
1. Anti-Ragging Awareness during Orientation Program

- **Dates:** 5th July 2025 (FYBSc.IT) and 14th July 2025 (FYBSc. Home Science)
- **Number of beneficiaries-**FYBSc- 100 and BSc IT- 40
- Orientation sessions included anti-ragging awareness modules to educate first-year students about policies, support systems, and reporting mechanisms.

2. Awareness Lecture / Talk

- **Date:** 12th July 2025
- **Speaker:** Ms. Fatema Fanuswala (College Counsellor)
- **Topic:** *“The Importance of Creating a Safe, Inclusive and Respectful Campus Environment”*

3. Anti ragging video display- As a part of the awareness program all classes displayed a short video on evils of ragging on campus. This activity was taken up on 14th August 2025 between 9.00 to 10.30.
