Agenda III: To record and take action on cases, if any are reported on campus

Dr. Vinaya informed the members that all students have completed the online Anti-Ragging Undertaking on the UGC website. Both students and their parents submitted the forms. The college has collected all the Anti-Ragging reference numbers and filed them properly in the Anti-Ragging File.

She added that the college strictly follows a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging and fully complies with all the rules and guidelines given by the UGC and the parent university.

During the meeting, an important decision was made. With agreement from all members, it was decided that the student affidavits and college compliance will be completed during the admission process itself. Since students submit the affidavit on the UGC portal at the time of admission, doing the college's compliance at the same time will make the process smoother. This update will be shared with the Admission Committee as a proactive step.

Ms. Sandhya Lele, the parent representative, agreed with this approach and appreciated the college's efforts in creating awareness. She also mentioned that there have been no ragging cases reported on campus.

Mr. Khan confirmed that no ragging cases have been reported through the college portal or email.
