Subject-wise teaching plans are prepared by all the teachers & reviewed monthly by the Head of Department. The department planner and academic calendar helps to ensure that the schedule is followed. The Academic calendar & course syllabus is available on the college website & is accessible to all the students at the beginning of the semester. Faculty members take utmost care to complete the syllabus in time. Tutorials/projects, class tests and internal assessments comprise the formal evaluative processes, but students are encouraged to meet faculty beyond classroom hours for doubt clearing and curricular discussions. Teachers use various learning methodologies like flipped classroom, experiential learning, and case study to help students understand the concepts better.
